

Welcome to Willkie


We are proud to continue our trainee solicitor programme in London, and look forward to welcoming our new trainees in September 2024 and to meeting potential new trainees over the next 12 months.


Tax

Diversity, Equity and Inclusion

London initiatives include:

Affinity Groups

We have several active affinity groups, aimed at promoting inclusiveness and community in London. Groups include members representing the LGBTQI+ community, parents, the Jewish community, neurodiversity and those with

minority ethnic heritage. We also have the London Chapter of the Women's Professional Development Committee (WPDC). The WPDC was established more than a decade ago to offer professional development programmes and guidance.

Mentoring

Trainees, paralegals and associates benefit from our mentoring programme. Trainees are assigned one partner and two associate mentors each year, with mentor pairing rotating each year until associates reach 6PQE. Our mentoring programme provides the opportunity for our people to enhance their visibility and benefit from career guidance and practical advice from other professionals across several practice areas.


RARE

Some 20 per cent of our London partners, associates and trainees have volunteered to mentor one or two GROW candidates.





Pro Bono and Community Work

Pro Bono

In London, our lawyers work on a number of different projects, both in the UK and the US, certain of which are listed below. Our London office encourages our lawyers to introduce new pro bono matters to the firm. Additionally, our London lawyers work in partnership with attorneys in our US offices on immigration, family law and other pro bono matters.

Probonoskills effectively supports individuals so that they can do more, help more, and achieve more for local communities. Several London associates have delivered webinars on corporate topics and will continue to support Probonoskills' expansion in the UK.

Cleantech Accelerator Programme:

The Green Tech Legal Collaborative, a groundbreaking probono initiative founded by Willkie, Bloomberg L.P. and other firms, has been shortlisted for ESG Programme of the Year at the 2024 Legal Business Awards. The Green Tech Legal Collaborative, launched in 2021, provides probono legal and compliance support for green tech start-ups from Imperial College's Enterprise Lab.

The Queen Mary University of London Legal Advice Centre Our trainees and associates volunteer at QMUL's student led legal advice clinics.

Community work

We recognise the need to partner with local communities and, in London, we partner with a local school, providing work experience placements for at least two Year 11 or 12 students each year. Additionally, we have one paid apprenticeship a year, for a school leaver to work in our business services team. A number of our lawyers in London regularly mentor a Law student from Queen Mary University of London to provide advice on a career in law and to help develop each mentee's commercial awareness.

Training Contracts

From 1 September 2024, we are recruiting trainee solicitors who can start their training contract in September 2027. We recruit our future trainee solicitors from our spring and summer vacation schemes only.

Our training contract provides an environment where junior lawyers can excel and be challenged, in a supportive environment. You will sit in four different practice areas, with a mix of partners and associates. You will spend six months in Litigation and Investigations & Enforcement and six months in Private Equity or Corporate Insurance (M&A).

In addition to the full programme of formal training, you will work alongside our partners and associates in small teams on real matters from day one. Our people work in small, nimble teams on high-quality matters, so it is important that you are motivated, collaborative and able to pick things up quickly as you will receive a great breadth of work from the outset.

Willkie London has grown by over 160% over the past six years and by 51% since 2020 alone. With this in mind, we are looking for self-starters who want to contribute to a dynamic, growing workplace, and who have a genuine interest in Willkie and our clients.

Vacation Schemes

We recruit trainee solicitors via our vacation schemes. In 2025, we will have up to 20 people in total on our spring and summer vacation schemes.

During your two-week scheme, you will sit in two different teams, with a partner and an associate, and gain hands-on experience, giving you the opportunity to undertake real, meaningful work and showcase your potential.

We hope that by the end of the two weeks, you will have met most of our people at our vacation scheme-specific workshops, seminars and social events. You will be supported throughout your time with us, by a partner mentor, an associate buddy and our graduate recruitment team, and will be paid £750 per week.

The application deadline is 20 December 2024. Successful applications will be invited to a video interview and, if successful at this stage, will be invited to complete a written exercise. Our final stage of recruitment is a CV-blind interview with partners.



Law School

For those who have accepted a training contract with us, we offer full sponsorship of the GDL and SQE (as appropriate) which covers course fees in full and a £17,500 maintenance grant, pro-rated.

We will ask future trainees to complete the SQE (if they have not already completed the LPC). We are partnering with University of Law to deliver market-leading qualifications that we believe will prepare our future trainees for practice. All future trainees will study the LLM Legal Practice, which incorporates preparation for SQE 1 & 2 as well as the SQE Plus, an enhanced programmed designed to go beyond the standard SQE syllabus to ensure our trainees can be confident in their ability to hit the ground running.

Future trainees who have not studied law in England and Wales will take the nine-month Postgraduate Diploma in Law, before the LLM Legal Practice, to ensure they have a solid academic foundation in law.

Benefits

Our benefits include: 25 days' annual leave, Cycle to Work scheme, employee assistance programme for employees and their families, employer pension contribution, eye test, health & well-being allowance, interest-free season ticket loan, life assurance, private dental insurance, private medical insurance and a technology programme.

Life at Willkie

We hold a retreat every two years for all European lawyers, taking placing over several days. Most recently, in 2023, over 200 Willkie lawyers from all our European offices gathered in Portugal.
