





Diversity, Equity and Inclusion

Diversity, Equity & Inclusion (DEI) is at the heart of Willkie's values, in our London office and at the firm generally. 2023 saw the re-launch of our DEI Working Group in London and the appointment of partner Kirsty Maclean to lead our DEI initiatives in London, supported by a working group which represents partners, associates, trainees, paralegals and business professional staff. This re-invigoration represents a step-up in energy and support of our DEI strategy and goals.

London initiatives include:

Affinity Groups

We have several active affinity groups, aimed at promoting inclusiveness and community in London. Groups include members representing the LGBTQI+ community, parents, the Jewish community and those with minority ethnic heritage. We also have the London Chapter of the Women's Professional Development Committee (WPDC). The WPDC was established more than a decade ago to offer professional development programmes and guidance to ensure that Willkie provides a rewarding and empowering experience to women at the firm.

Mentoring

Trainees, paralegals and associates benefit from our mentoring programme. Trainees are assigned one partner and two associate mentors each year, with mentor pairing rotating each year until associates reach 6PQE. Our mentoring programme provides the opportunity for our people to enhance their visibility and benefit from career guidance and practical advice from other professionals across several practice areas.

Training Contracts

From 1 September 2023, we are recruiting trainee solicitors who can start their training contract in September 2026. We recruit our future trainee solicitors from our spring and summer vacation schemes only.

Our training contract provides an environment where junior lawyers can excel and be challenged, in a supportive environment. You will sit in four different practice areas, with a mix of partners and associates. You will spend six months in Litigation and Investigations & Enforcement and six months in Private Equity or Corporate Insurance (M&A).

In addition to the full programme of formal training, you will work alongside our partners and associates in small teams on real matters from day one. Our people work in small, nimble teams on high-quality matters, so it is important that you are motivated, collaborative and able to pick things up quickly as you will receive a great breadth of work from the outset.

Vacation **Schemes**

We recruit trainee solicitors via our vacation schemes. In 2024, we will have up to 20 people in total on our spring and summer vacation schemes.

During your two-week scheme, you will sit in two different teams, with a partner and an associate, and gain hands-on experience, giving you the opportunity to undertake real, meaningful work and showcase your potential.

We hope that by the end of the two weeks, you will have met most of our people at our vacation scheme-specific workshops, seminars and social events. You will be supported throughout your time with us, by a partner mentor, an associate buddy and our graduate recruitment team, and will be paid £550 per week.

The application deadline is 20 December 2023. Successful applications will be invited to a video interview and, if successful at this stage, will be invited to complete a written exercise. Our final stage of recruitment is a CV-blind interview with partners.

We welcome applicants from all universities and degree disciplines. We are looking for consistently strong academic achievement, with a 2.1 at undergraduate level.

Law School

For those who have accepted a training contract with us, we offer full sponsorship of the GDL and SQE (as appropriate) which covers course fees in full and a \pounds 17,500 maintenance grant, pro-rated.

We will ask future trainees to complete the SQE (if they have not already completed the LPC). We are partnering with University of Law to deliver market-leading qualifications that we believe will prepare our future trainees for practice. All future trainees will study the LLM Legal Practice, which incorporates preparation for SQE1&2 as well as the SQE Plus, an enhanced programmed designed to go beyond the standard SQE syllabus to ensure our trainees can be confident in their ability to hit the ground running.

Future trainees who have not studied law in England and Wales will take the nine-month Postgraduate Diploma in Law, before the LLM Legal Practice, to ensure they have a solid academic foundation in law.

Benefits

Our benefits include: 25 days' annual leave, Cycle to Work scheme, employee assistance programme for employees and their families, employer pension contribution, eye test, health & well-being allowance, interest-free season ticket loan, life assurance, private dental insurance, private medical insurance and a technology programme.
